- 1. Call to order:
  - a. Y Scoggin called the meeting to order at 5:05 PM.

### 2. Chair's Report and Announcement of Order:

a. Y Scoggin welcomed new board member M Dangerfield to the board and asked C Holt to check in with the city to see what next steps are regarding signing. Y Scoggin also requested that the annual report be presented at the next meeting to review the impact the SBD has made this past year.

### 3. Public Comments & Questions:

a. none

### 4. Approval of previous Meeting Minutes:

**a.** D Anderson motioned to approve the previous meeting minutes; B Jones seconded. All in favor – motion passed.

### 5. Public Safety:

- a. Neighborhood Security Initiative:
  - i. Crime Update: J Whyte gave an update on the crime occurrences in the district, noting a continued increase in crime compared to the past 5 years. J Whyte recommended Safe Haven Defense smash resistant windows as a solution for businesses in the region to deter break-ins. A Abdullah shared that the Grove's special taxing district approved a cost sharing program with businesses to cover the cost of installations and recommended that the CWE SE consider a similar program.
  - ii. Contribution Amount Approval: J Whyte provided an overview of the requested contribution amount for the NSI, suggesting the operation contribution be at \$81,300 and camera contribution to be \$15,750. M Dangerfield motioned to approve the contribution amount; R Kissel seconded. All in favor motion passed.
  - iii. Camera Project Proposal: J Whyte suggested a 3 to 5 year camera expansion proposal, identifying the intersections at Forest Park & Boyle, Lindell & Boyle, 4300 Lindell, Sarah & Lindell, Boyle & Laclede, as well as Lindell & Whittier as prime spots for installations. Y Scoggin recommended accepting the proposal as presented and to further discuss a funding strategy at the next meeting.
- b. The City's Finest, Rob Betts:

i. R Betts informed the board that patrol costs have increased and recommended the board consult with J Whyte when considering increasing their budget for patrols to continue receiving the same amount of patrolling they currently receive in the neighborhood.

## 6. Neighborhood Improvements:

- **a.** R Coleman gave the following community updates:
  - i. Laclede Lighting Project: R Coleman mentioned that the lighting project was expected to cost \$70,000 more than initially expected. A Abdul recommended seeing if any additional ward fund would be available to assist as the SBD has taken on the majority of funding for the project. Y Scoggin recommended that he, R Coleman and A Abdullah reach out to the alderperson to see if funding were available, and if not, to conduct an email vote.
  - ii. Sidewalk Repairs: R Coleman requested that Park Central work with him to conduct a sidewalk survey to identify areas needing repair.
  - iii. Infrastructure: Supply chains continue to run slow, slowing down progress with the litter barrels and streetlights that have not come in yet. The ADA ramps installation has been delayed and will continue once weather is better.
  - iv. Tree planting: R Coleman asked the board if they would consider funding \$5,000 to tree planting. Y Scoggin suggested tabling funding for the project until time is closer to planting season.

## 7. Project Report:

- a. **Financial Reports:** C. Holt gave a summary of the monthly financial reports. B Jones asked if a variance column could be added to the report. C Holt shared that he would check with PCDs accountant to see if one could be added. D Anderson shared that the reports provided are standard. B Jones motioned to approve the financials; R Kissel seconded. All in favor, motion approved.
- b. Liability Insurance Renewal Approval: C Holt gave an overview of the insurance renewal. R Kissel motioned to approve the new contract; M Dangerfield seconded. All in favor motion passed.
- c. **Bike Corrals:** C Holt gave an overview of bike corral options and costs. R Coleman recommended working with Mike Woodling for installation.

### 8. Other Business:

- a. **December Meeting:** R Kissel asked what next months meeting would look like given the holiday season. Y Scoggin suggested having a hybrid meeting option in December due to the holidays and possible weather concerns.
- 9. **Meeting Adjourned:** Y Scoggin adjourned the meeting at 6:19 PM.
